GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

Wiedeman and Singleton, Inc. is a civil and environmental consulting engineering firm that provides planning, design, and construction related engineering services to municipal clients in the Southeast. We are looking for a motivated and capable civil engineer interested in providing engineering solutions on our municipal water and wastewater infrastructure projects, which include pipelines, pumping stations, and treatment facilities. This position will allow you to use all your civil engineering training (e.g., hydraulics, water and wastewater treatment process design, hydrology, etc.) as you are mentored to become a Professional Engineer and to eventually manage your own engineering projects. After initial training in our Rock Hill office, this is a hybrid work position with time split between the office and remote using company provided computer equipment. You will be required to permanently maintain your residence within 60 miles of our office as a condition of employment.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

General duties and responsibilities will include the following:

- Perform civil engineering calculations under the supervision of a Professional Engineer.
- Work closely with your colleagues to prepare engineering reports, construction plans, and technical specifications.
- Provide engineering support during construction and start-up of projects. This will include such tasks as reviewing shop drawing submissions; visiting sites to observe construction progress; and assisting with the startup of major process equipment.

EXPERIENCE/EDUCATION/QUALIFICATIONS

- A four (4) year Bachelor of Science degree from an ABET accredited school in Civil Engineering.
- Entry Level Position – Engineer In Training.
- FE Exam Certification or ability to obtain.
- Experience in AutoCAD, AutoCAD Civil 3D, and Revit are preferred, but not required. On-the-job training will be provided.
- A Valid Driver's license is required.
